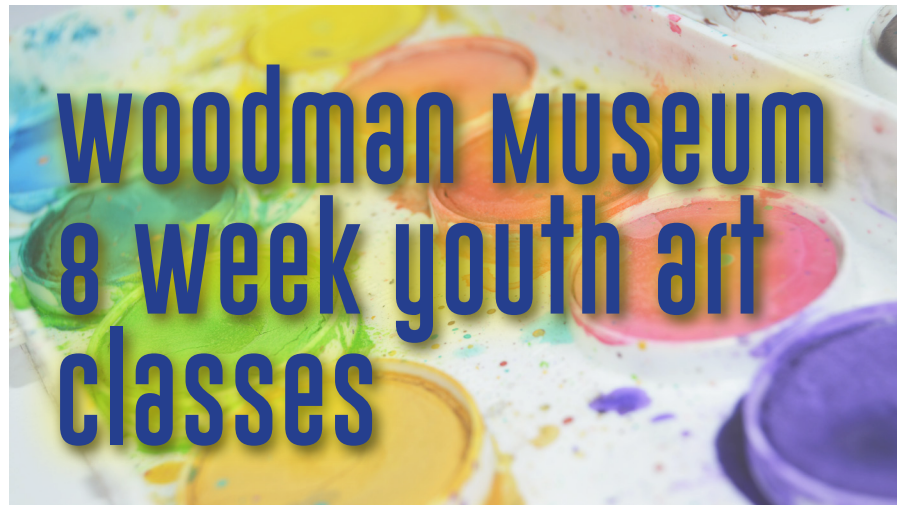

## **DRAWING UNIT**

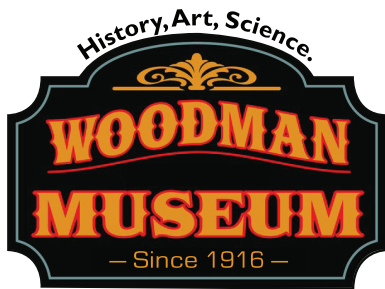
*Lines and measuring | Introduction to value | Negative space | Building on the skills cultivated in the previous lessons*
